Ed Note(2): Some readers have commented on the omission of tide tables for Burnham-on-Crouch in the 2010 edition of the Small Craft Almanac. This is because Burnham is no longer a Standard Port in the Admiralty Tide Tables (ATT). In the interests of accuracy, therefore, we have now included Burnham as a Secondary Port to Walton-on-the-Naze, as shown in ATT.
